What is going on ? !!

- The shell path walkway around the big lake has been refurbished
- Work is being done around the Rec Center and pool:
 The island has new sod and the palms trimmed
 - A new grill, tank, and cover were purchased to replace the old

★ The tennis courts and basketball court are in the process of being resurfaced and re-done with new lighting.

★ The tennis courts will also be striped for PICKLEBALL (which should not interfere with tennis lines)

- ➤ The basketball goal will be separate from the tennis courts
- ✤ Playground equipment for younger children is going to be added to the area
- Landscaping crews have been freshening up the berm and have replanted 3 threes at the second island south entrance
- A pergola will be installed near the condos where the tree was removed at the clubhouse
- Street signs, street lights and mailboxes are topics of discussion
- A homeowner has suggested a putting green be added to the community and we are researching this suggestion
