CALL TO ORDER The meeting was called to order by Alex Aldama at 6:40PM.

APPROVAL OF THE PREVIOUS MINUTES: MOTION made by Brian, seconded by Suzanne to approve the April 16, 2019 minutes as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Unfinished Business:

- **South Entrance** A lot of work has been done but it is still incomplete. There are six low voltage transformers that light up the area. Owens Electric was on site today to look at the northside of the South Entrance which is not currently working. The landscaping was discussed.
- FOB System Tabled to June.
- Clubhouse Renovation- Underway.

New Business:

- Irrigation Replacement Two of the three pumps need to be replaced. This is approved.
- Tree Trimming at Clubhouse Greenworks will take care of this.
- Rec Center Pool Door- This will be rebuilt next week.
- Rec Center railing slats and slats under the staircase Caleb will take care of it.
- **Shell for Basketball Court-** Greenworks will take care of this. **MOTION** made by Brian, seconded by Alex to approve as presented. MOTION passed unanimously.
- Shell for path- Alternatives to shell was discussed. Concrete slabs were discussed.
- Pool Maintenance Service MOTION made by David, seconded by Alex to approve to pay for Caleb Allen to attend the Pool certification class. Once certified, Swim Rite maintenance service will be discontinued. MOTION passed unanimously.
- Sarasota County has contacted Sunstate regarding a utility easement along Bahia Vista.
- Sarasota County Grant Program- The Lakes Maintenance Board is working on the Sarasota County Matching Funds Grant program (up to \$10,000). Alex and David have attended the County Seminar. Alex and David provided details to the Board Directors on the program.
- Umbrellas at both pools have been installed.
